ENFORCEMENT NOTICE**

To Linx Printing Technologies Ltd, 8 Stocks Bridge Way, St Ives Cambridgeshire PE27 5JL

Huntingdonshire District Council ("the Council") in the exercise of the powers conferred upon it by regulation 36 of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 ("the 2016 Regulations") hereby gives you notice as follows:

The Council is of the opinion that you have contravened and are contravening conditions of your permit **B04/94** granted under regulation 13 of the 2016 Regulations in respect of the operation of the installation at:-

Linx Printing Technologies Ltd, 33 Edison Road, St Ives PE27 3LF

The matters constituting such contravention are:-

Condition 3: Breach of VOC emission limit

The steps you are required to take to remedy the contravention or to ensure that the likely contravention does not occur are:

Provide adequate abatement to ensure the emission limit is met and provide the Council with a report that describes the method, results and conclusions of the annual stack emission sampling

Such steps must be taken within a period of **1 year** from the date of the service of this notice to you.

Failure to comply with the terms of this notice will render you liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding of £50,000 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding twelve months, or to both, or on conviction on indictment to a fine or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 5 years, or to both.

APPEALS

If you wish to appeal against this notice you must do so within two months of the service of the notice on you.

You are legally required to provide:

- written notice of the appeal;
- a statement of the grounds of appeal;
- a copy of any relevant application;
- a copy of any relevant environmental permit;
- a copy of any relevant correspondence between you and the regulator;
- a copy of any decision or notice which is the subject matter of the appeal; and
- a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be dealt with by written representations procedure or a hearing - a hearing must be held if either you or the Council requests this, or if the Planning Inspector or Secretary of State decides to hold one

You should state whether any of the information enclosed with the appeal notice has been the subject of a successful application for commercial confidentiality under regulation 48 of the 2010 Regulations, and provide relevant details. Unless such information is provided all documents submitted will be open to inspection.
