RE: MARSHALLS MONO. PRODUCTION UNIT 1990, PART 1
MATERIALS CONTROL AND WASTE PREVENTION PROGRAMME

Enclosed please find the details of an authorisation to operate a permitted process involving the blending, packing and storage of silos of cement following your application dated 11th November 1991.

As stated in the above letter you have accepted all the conditions of this authorisation and you will be required to meet these conditions for the current financial year. As there are now two full months remaining in this financial year the amount due will be:

$1550 \times 2/12 = 258.33$

Please consider the conditions carefully and submit your programme for compliance within 6 months of the date of issue of the authorisation.

Although I am satisfied that there is no immediate requirement for additional emission control equipment, you will be required to provide a procedure by which each of the conditions are met including who will be responsible for carrying out visual assessments, who will supervise silo filling operations, who will carry out checks on alarms and update the log, and who will carry out the monthly inspections of the equipment concerned with the prevention of emissions to air etc.

You will note that there is no condition requiring the continuous sampling or monitoring of emissions to air from the silos other than by visual assessment. This will be reviewed in due course and may become a future requirement if visual monitoring reveals persistent maloperation.

I will make routine visits to the premises to ensure that the conditions of the authorisation are adhered to. Please note that the log book should be commenced immediately and this is viewed as a most important document.
