I confirm my visit on 16 May 2003 at which time a routine compliance inspection was undertaken with respect to the above authorisation. At the time of visit I was satisfied that the operations on site were compliant with the conditions contained within the authorisation.

As explained in my letter of 17 April 2003, your EPA Authorisation will need transferring to a Pollution Prevention and Control "Permit" written under the Pollution Prevention and Control Act 1999 and the Pollution Prevention and Control (England and Wales) Regulations 2000, within this financial year.

During the permitting process we will need to re-assess the "installation" boundary in accordance with the new legislation. This document provides a useful introduction to the PPC Regs. Page 9 to 12 provides a useful introduction while page 13 explains what an activity, installation and "technical connection" is, however, you will need to refer to Annex III (p151) to find full definitions and examples. Remember that the activity at Marshalls will remain a Part B so the permit will only concern emissions to air.
