Exemption 24 of the above regulations states:

**Crushing, grinding or size reduction of bricks, tiles or concrete**

- 24 – (1) Storage at the place where crushing is carried on of any waste bricks, tiles or concrete which is intended to be crushed if –
- (a) the total quantity of such waste stored at that place at any time does not exceed 20,000 tonnes; and
  - (b) where crushing is carried on otherwise than at the place where such waste is produced, the crushing is carried on with a view to the recovery or reuse of the waste.
- (2) In this paragraph, “crushing” means crushing, grinding or other size reduction under an environmental permit to the extent it is an activity within paragraph (a) of Part B of Section 3.5 of Part of Schedule 1.
