**Introduction**

**When to use this form**

This regime is known as Local Authority Pollution Prevention and Control, LAPPC. Installations permitted under this regime are known as "Part B" installations. Use this form if you are applying for a permit to a Local Authority to operate a waste oil burner with a net rated thermal input of less than 0.4MW, and burn only your own arisings of oil.



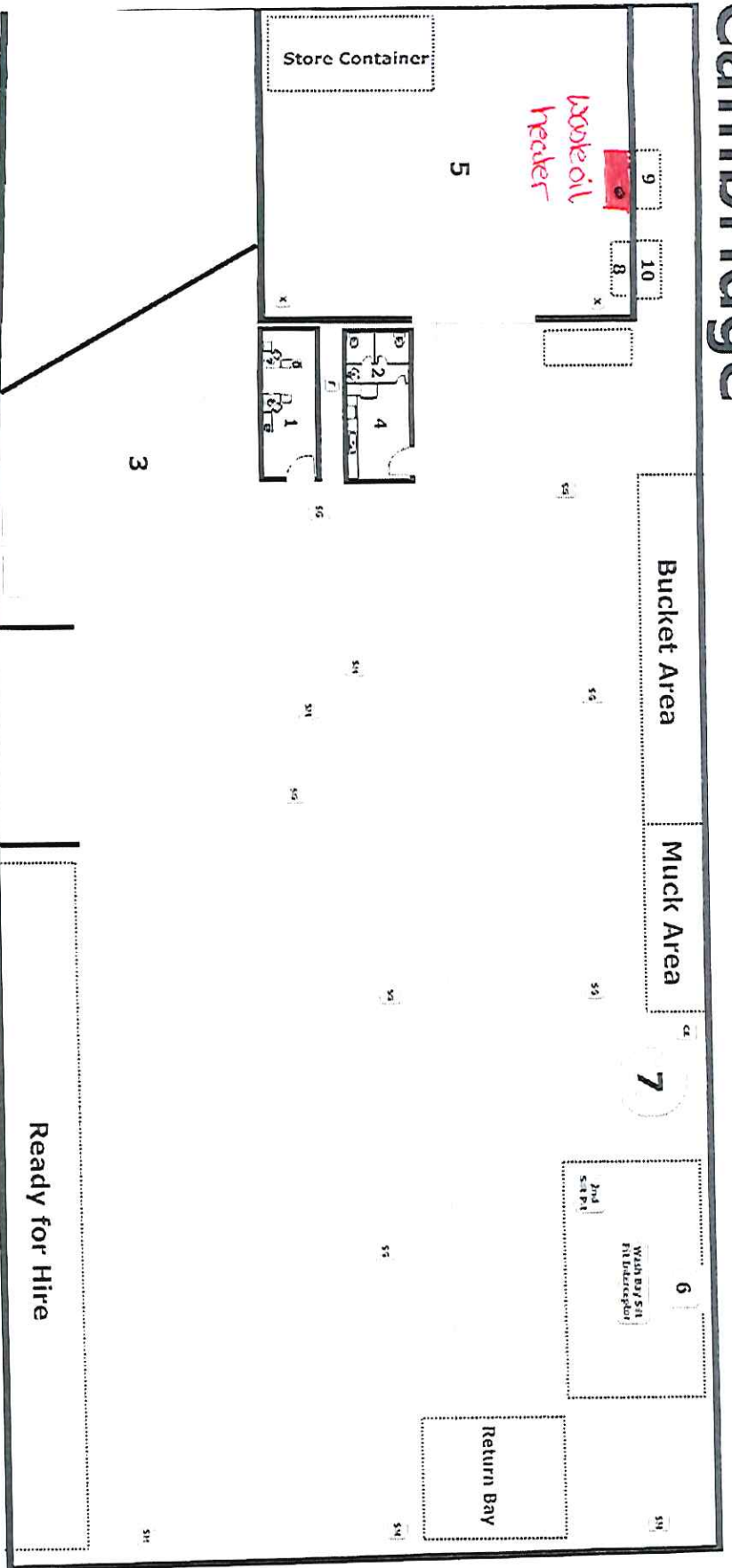
