Daily visual assessment log sheets seen. Continuous monitoring alarm testing system still being
implemented, hoping to have it fitted in September (condition 6). Operator to confirm when completed.
Monitoring system due to be calibrated next month (annually). During April and October Marshalls
Mono Ltd usually shut down for routine maintenance, during which an external company come in to
service the silos. Hy Control maintain the system and complete maintenance twice annually, one
minor and one major service. Last one was completed during the April shut down period. Training
records seen. Site inspection completed, no issues noted. Signage and procedures in place to limit
deliveries to 1 bar pressure. Company still has ISO14001.
