Comments

A new silo is being planned which will be larger than the current silos and will enable a different produce without having to clear/clean out the existing silos. Emission test was done in Feb 2017 and showed compliance with limits. Operator is trying harder to keep the area clear of material which is as much a fire risk as dust risk. Preventative maintenance is now electronic with the option for operatives to raise issues. A lot of new staff have been employed and training of standard operating procedures etc. has occurred. Company is working towards ISO14001.
