Comments

Emission test undertaken end September beginning October, undertaken by a new company but initial indication didn't highlight any problems. There has been an increase in employees with training undertaken and records kept by HR. All employees are aware of the responsibilities but under general training and not dedicated to EPR (doesn't need to be). Maintenance department keeps records and has regular maintenance/cleaning regime of plant. No significant spillages/breakages over previous year. VOC usage still under 5 tonnes. Last variation Jan 2010 so variation of permit required following next inspection. Operator has an internal environmental management system and is considering to get ISO14001 in the future.
