Operator has 2 treatment vessels and so leaves treated timber of racking and inside vessel as long
as possible to ensure dry before moving to storage area. Maintenance checks and training
undertaken and recorded. Area has dedicated trained and experienced operators and is training
more people to be able to use the plant. Timber is placed in the vessel carefully to ensure it is at
an angle to help with run-off. Company has ISO14001.
