Comments

Emission test for year 2013-14 not undertaken. The next test is booked in for 7th July 2014. Only serious plant breakdown has been on the pelleting line which did not cause any emissions to atmosphere but prevented pelleting occurring. The new maintenance engineer is in place. He is fully trained for engineering but has yet completed the environmental training in relation to the permit (although he is aware of environmental permitting. There is a fair amount of straw on the floor which keeps the dust levels down. There is some build-up of material around the process plant but no evidence it is escaping off site. Maintenance and daily check records being transferred to electronic systems. No emission test results submitted to HDC within 8 week period as required by condition 4.
