

MET Area Housekeeping Notice

- 1. Keep the floor areas clear of airlines and extension leads when not in use.
- 2. Keep the **minimum** of tools and equipment required within the immediate working areas.
- 3. Items such as mechanical components should be transferred to stores until required.
- 4. All consumable products such as oils, greases etc. must be kept in their designated bin location until required.
- 5. Vehicle exhaust fumes must be kept to a minimum by using the fume extraction equipment provided.
- 6. Large mobile equipment such as engine hoists, oil drainers etc. must be allocated to their designated equipment parking area after use.
- 7. Always replace the lids on all tins of liquid consumables after use to avoid accidental spillage.
- 8. Fugitive particulate emissions arising from sanding, grinding and dust from brake dismantling shall be collected by vacuuming or otherwise by wet methods regularly during the working day.
- 9. Crush all empty and discarded cardboard cartons and packing and dispose of in the proper manner.
- 10. All dry waste must be bagged prior to disposal in the designated waste skip.
- 11. All wet waste such as oils, contaminated fuels, brake fluids, anti freeze fluids etc. must be disposed in to the designated waste container.
