FLUEING REQUIREMENTS AND MINIMUM CHIMNEY



The flue must terminate at least one metre higher than the highest point of the roof
 minimum of 6 metres from floor level to the top of the flue for the SB40 Model and 7 metres for
 the SB40 Model.

If the flue extends more than 2 metres above the roof it should be supported by guy wires.

Vertical and horizontal pipes must NOT be used in flues.

When the flue passes through a wall or ceiling of combustible material it must be enclosed by a sleeve
 of non-combustible material and separated from the sleeve by at least 25mm air gap. The
 temperature of any combustible material near the flue or heater must not exceed 100°C when the
 heater is operating. The flue must also be at least 50mm from any other combustible material.
 The space between the flue and roof or wall must be made good to prevent water ingress.

The flue should be installed and supported so that the heater does not carry any flue weight and the
 installation must comply with the relevant codes of practice.
